- Font: Times New Roman, size 10pt, single line spacing, justified;

Use the full name of the first author to identify the file you submit (e.g. radu\_ionescu.doc)

Title of the paper should be concise and informative<sup>1</sup>.

Text should be written in neuter gender, concisely and in correct orthography.

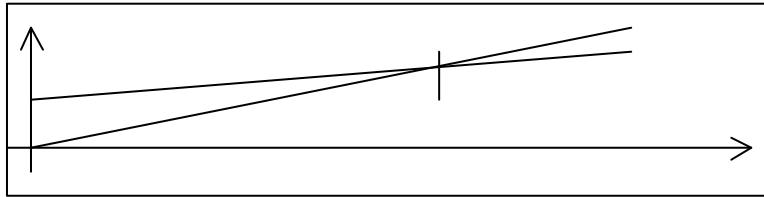
The author is responsible for language editing.
